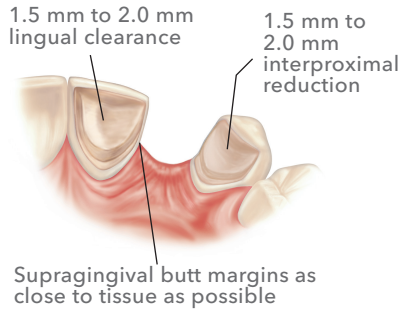
Facial reduction:

Cutback - 1.0 mm to 1.5 mm



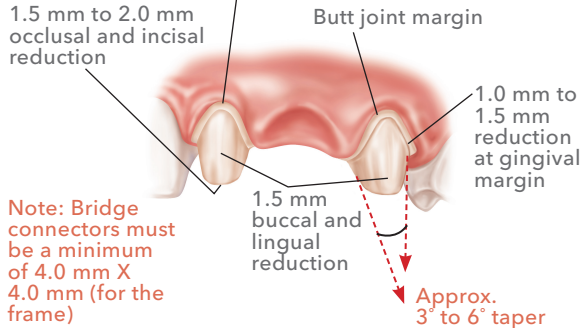
- Note:**
